"The Board of Directors agrees with Thomas Muurmann Henriksen's decision on immediate resignation, as it is clear that peace can't be created in the company as a result of the process that has been described in the press," says Chairman of the Board of DanBred, Christian Junker, and continues:

"There is no doubt that this has been a difficult and complex case. We, on the Board of Directors, have always taken the accusations of inappropriate behavior very seriously, and as I have mentioned earlier, it was from a holistic point of view that the Board of Directors chose to let Thomas Muurmann continue as director of the company. That Thomas today wanted to retire from his post is a correct disposition." he says.

The work of creating security and trust continues.

"The Board of Directors will of course continue to focus on implementing the specific measures that were decided as a result of the case of inappropriate behavior. The measures must ensure security and trust for all DanBred employees." concludes Christian Junker.
